



Scent Diffuser Standard Maintenance Cleaning Guide

1

Disconnect the power supply and open the diffuser's fragrance oil bottle.





2

Remove the
fragrance oil
bottle from the
device.

3

If any oil remains in the bottle, pour it into an empty container for reuse.





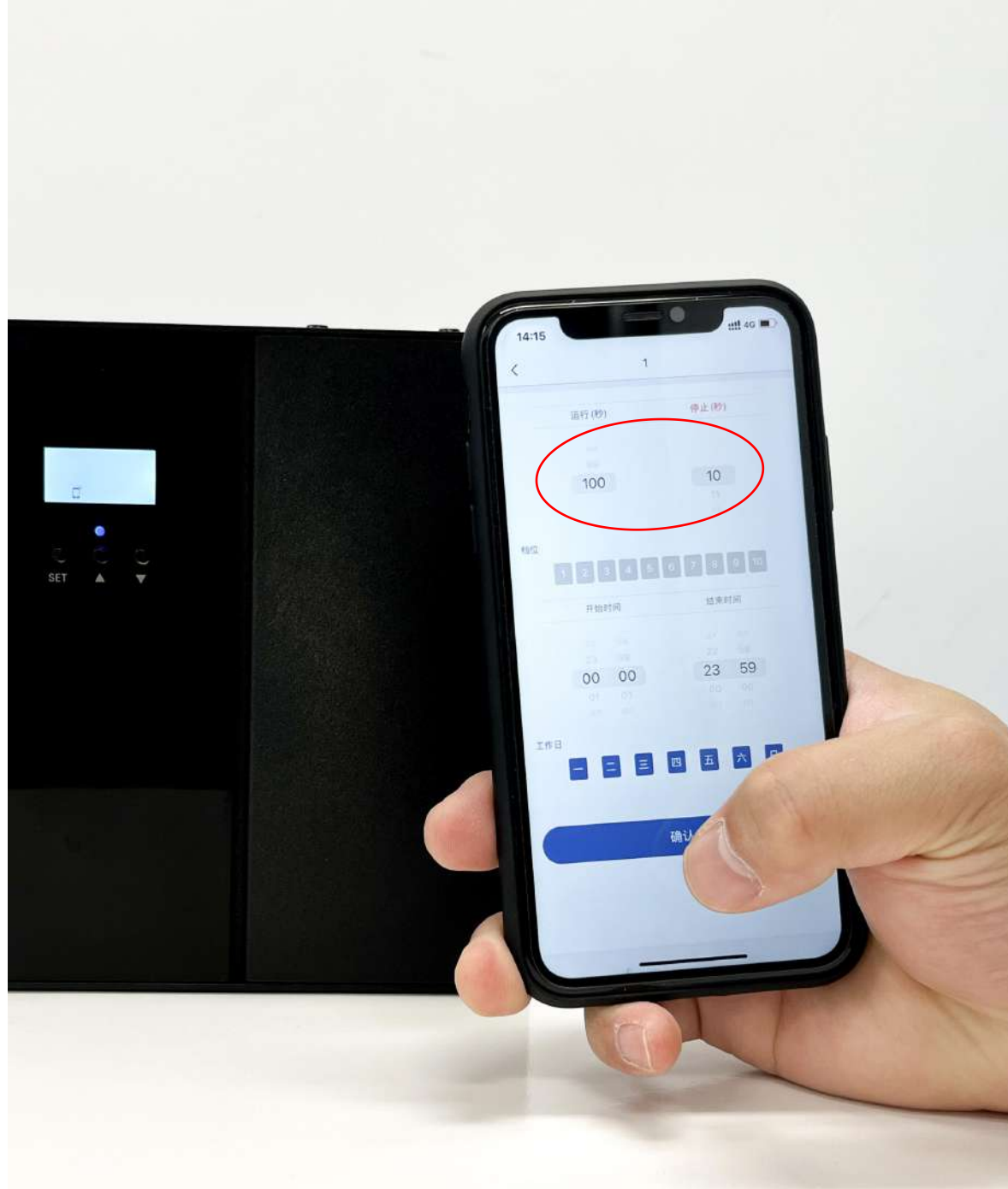

Pour 75% concentration alcohol into the removed bottle until it is $\frac{1}{3}$ full. Shake vigorously for one minute to clean residual oil, then pour out the used alcohol (collect in a designated waste container; do not discard improperly).

Pour fresh 75% concentration alcohol into the cleaned bottle until 1/3 full. Screw the bottle back into the diffuser.





6

Reconnect the power, turn on the diffuser, and set it to the maximum output level. Allow it to atomize for 5-8 minutes.

After atomization, disconnect the power. Pour out the remaining alcohol (collect in the designated waste container; do not discard improperly).





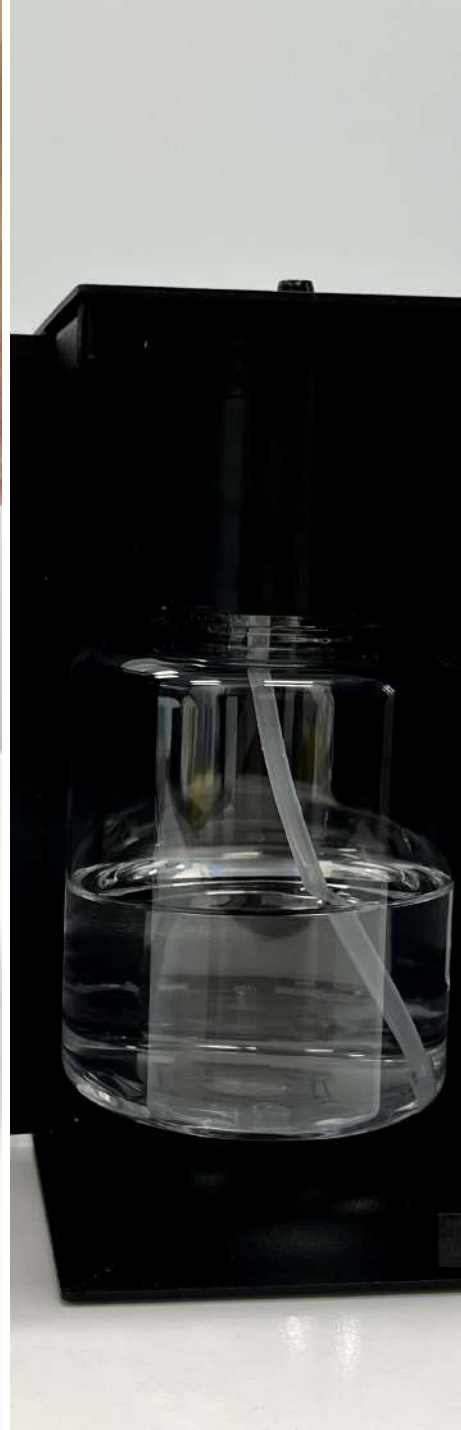

Dampen a cotton cloth with an appropriate amount of alcohol and wipe the atomizer nozzle and the diffuser body.

Then, use a dry cotton cloth to wipe the atomizer nozzle and the diffuser body. The cleaning is now complete.





10

Refill the fragrance oil bottle with fresh oil, screw it securely into the unit, and close the reservoir door.

11

Check the device to ensure everything is normal, then plug in the power and turn on the diffuser.





12

Adjust the scent output level back to its original setting.

13

On-site cleaning is complete. Recover all on-site waste materials and clean the work area.
